Jackson Hole Children's Museum Moving in May: Closure from April 27-June 8, 2019

Jackson, WY – Thanks to a generous lease extension by the Town of Jackson, Jackson Hole Children's Museum will remain open in their current King Street location until April 26th. **The Museum will be closed April 27 through June 8.** The Museum will be open during Spring Break, and Members will receive a two-month extension due to the closure.

The Museum will re-open at their new location at the Jackson Elementary School Annex buildings for Touch-A-Truck on Sunday, June 9th. Touch-A-Truck 2019 will be located on Jean Street adjacent to the new Museum.

“We are grateful for our partnership with Teton County School District,” said Jean Lewis, JHCM Executive Director. “The annex buildings will be an ideal transitional home as we continue our search for a long-term facility.”
