The Jackson Hole Children's Museum 2021 Touch-a-Truck COVID Mitigation Plan

FACE COVERINGS:

Face coverings are required for all event attendees age 3 and older. Mask wearing will be encouraged for younger visitors. JHCM staff will have free face masks for children and adults available at the entrance of the event on Jean Street. All staff, volunteers, and vehicle operators will be required to wear face coverings.

HAND HYGIENE:

All attendees will be strongly encouraged to use hand sanitizer at the entrance of the event on Jean Street, which will help ensure that every attendee starts the event with "clean" hands. Additional hand sanitizer stations will be placed throughout the event with signage encouraging use.

SOCIAL DISTANCING:

Indicators on the ground will give attendees visual aids to remain socially distanced as they enter and proceed throughout the event. Activity booths will be designed for social distancing and signs will also be placed in strategic locations to encourage social distancing. Periodic announcements will also be made.

CLEANING AND DISINFECTING:

Attendees will be strongly encouraged to use hand sanitizer at the entrance of the event on Jean Street. In addition, vehicle operators or volunteers will sanitize the "high touch" surfaces in and on their vehicles before the event and every hour after. Vehicle disinfecting will use CDC approved wipes or sprays depending on the vehicle owner's preference. Activity areas will also sanitize "high touch" equipment or supplies at least every hour using CDC approved wipes and/or a bleach-water solution (250-500ppm).

EMPLOYEE TESTING:

All staff, volunteers, and vehicle operators will be screened for symptoms and exposure before the event. All JHCM staff will be partially or fully vaccinated at the time of the event and will take a Covid test the week prior to the event. Anyone showing symptoms or potentially exposed to someone showing symptoms or testing positive in the 14 days before the event will not be allowed to participate.

ATTENDANCE REGULATIONS:

In order to encourage social distancing and ensure attendance levels do not exceed the limits set by the Town and/or Special Events Department at any given time, attendees will need to pre-register for an entry time and will be encouraged to limit their visit to an hour or less. Using an online-signup will allow JHCM to restrict and monitor the number of people entering or in attendance at any given time. Attendance will be restricted to allowing no more than 150 people to enter in any 30 minute window or 75 people in any 15 minute window.

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
