This Sunday - Jackson Hole Children's Museum Re-Opening and 7th Annual Touch-A-Truck

Jackson, WY – On Sunday, June 9, the Museum will re-open on North Jean Street in the eastern annex buildings of the Jackson Elementary campus. Touch-A-Truck, the Museum's largest fundraiser, will be held the same day from 10 AM to 2 PM.

Touch-A-Truck is a family-friendly event where vehicles — *construction, emergency, law enforcement, food service, recreation and more* — line the street, open for kids of all ages to explore in a safe, supervised environment. This event offers a unique opportunity to touch the levers, switches and gears that make kids' favorite rigs whir, as well as meet the vehicle operators who build, serve and protect our community every day.

In addition to the truck extravaganza, event-goers are invited to enjoy a Strider bike course hosted by Friends of Pathways, face painting, bouncy house, tasty food from Pinky G's Pizzeria, Momo Shack and Jackson Hole POP!, Teton County Library Book Bike, and interactive museum exhibits. The Museum will be open for play and exploration throughout the event. Admission to Touch-a-Truck is free, with a suggested donation of \$5/person or \$20/family.

“We are thrilled to re-open at Touch-A-Truck,” said JHCM Executive Director Jean Lewis. “Each year the event gets bigger and better, thanks to our ever-growing fleet of vehicles, their dynamic operators and our enthusiastic young patrons. We hope to have record-breaking attendance this year!”
